
TOBYMAC'S HITS DEEP 2026 ANNOUNCED WITH ARTISTS CROWDER AND JEREMY CAMP

ABOUT TOBYMAC: With more than 16 million units in career sales, four billion global streams, and a whopping seven GRAMMY® Awards, TobyMac's career continues to run on the fast track. His last project, LIFE AFTER DEATH debuted at No.1 on Billboard's Christian Albums chart in August 2022, garnered TobyMac his 17th GRAMMY® nomination and has amassed more than 548 million global streams to date. Named Pop/Contemporary Album of the Year at the 54th Annual GMA Dove Awards, the project boasts an incredible five number-one songs: "The Goodness (feat. Blessing Offor)," (whose music video won the Dove Award for Short Form Music Video of the Year), "Help Is On The Way (Maybe Midnight)," which peaked at No. 1 across five charts, "Promised Land,""Cornerstone (feat. Zach Williams),"and "Faithfully," the latter of two which held onto the top spot for ten consecutive weeks. LIFE AFTER DEATH follows his 2015 RIAA Certified Gold studio album, THIS IS NOT A TEST, which garnered a GRAMMY® Award and Billboard Music Award nomination on top of debuting at No. 4 on the Billboard Top 200. Each of his six studio solo projects have achieved RIAA Gold certification, a first for any artist in the history of his label, Capitol Christian Music Group. Among those is 2012's EYE ON IT, which debuted atop the Billboard 200, only the third Christian album ever to do so. THE ELEMENTS, his 2019 GRAMMY-nominated release, included "Everything," "Scars," "Edge of My Seat," "See The Light," and more alongside the charttopper, RIAA Gold Certified "I just need U." 2025 will bring brand new music with his 9th studio project, HEAVEN ON MY MIND.

ABOUT CROWDER: Known for his innovative blend of folk, rock, electronic and urban elements, Crowder's distinct style is characterized by his soulful vocals and eclectic instrumentation. His ability to seamlessly blend genres, from bluegrass to electronic, sets him apart, and with more than 2 Billion global streams, he is one of the most influential voices in Contemporary Christian Music. Armed with four No. 1 radio singles, five GRAMMY nominations, and more than 20 Dove Award nominations — five of those being wins — Crowder's exploration of faith, redemption, and personal transformation continue to catapult the genre forward. In addition to the awards and numerous RIAA Gold and Platinum certifications, the multi-instrumentalist is known for his genre-defying live performances that are anything but ordinary. Beyond his music, Crowder is also known for his philanthropic efforts and dedication to charitable causes. In 2024, he released his sixth studio album 'The EXILE,' the second in a three-part series that began with 'Milk & Honey' (2021). ABOUT JEREMY CAMP: Between 2002 and 2024, Jeremy Camp has released 14 albums, five of them RIAA-certified as Gold. He has sold over 7 million albums, over 4 Billion streams and with 46 #1 singles across all formats. His music has earned him numerous awards and nominations across the Christian and secular music industries, including five GMA Dove Awards, Grammy nomination, three American Music Award nominations, and four ASCAP Songwriter of the Year Awards. Camp was named Billboard's #2 Christian artist of the decade as well. Outside of music, in 2020 Jeremy had an international theatrical movie release called "I Still Believe" which hit #1 in the box office opening weekend. The film depicted his life story of love and loss of his first wife after a battle with cancer.
